Since age 5, Rob has displayed a natural ear and heart for music. Rob fine-tuned his skills at Berklee College of Music in Boston and has been composing, recording and performing ever since. His recent album, "All Is Right With The World," features multiple Grammy winning musicians, including band members of **Paul McCartney**, **Elton John** and **Sting**.

Inspired by the philanthropy and volunteerism of his parents, Rob is committed to using his talents and love of music to "make a difference" in the world. In November 2006, he founded **Melvincares.com**, an internet music distribution company that offers affordable access to music by participating independent artists, each with a social conscience. One-third of Melvincares.com income is donated to charitable organizations that fight global poverty.
